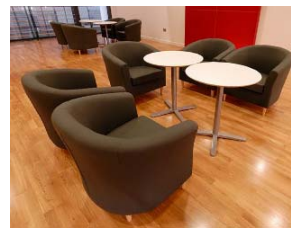

The new hall provides kitchen, dining and lounge areas as well as common rooms. There are specially adapted single study bedrooms with en suite facilities for students with disabilities.

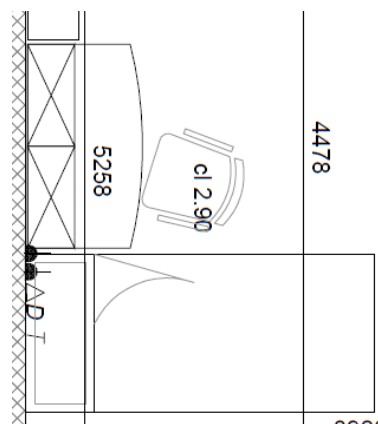


Due to the built in nature of the furniture, we had to work particularly closely with all the other trades on site; electricians, plasterers and decorators in particular.
